SYRACUSE STAGE ANNOUNCES YOUTH AUDITIONS FOR LIVELY IRISH MUSICAL ONCE

Local Youth Actors Aged 4 - 9 Years Invited to Open Auditions for the role of Ivanka



SYRACUSE, NY – Syracuse Stage is seeking local youth actors to audition for the role of Ivanka for its upcoming production of "**Once**," directed by Melissa Crespo.

Auditioners should note that the production schedule for "Once" includes morning student matinees in addition to regularly scheduled matinee and evening performances. The production runs May 1 through 19 and cast members must be available for rehearsals beginning on April 9 at Syracuse Stage. Rehearsals are not held on Mondays.

Young actors will not be required to be at all rehearsals. Rehearsals for youth actors will generally be held weekdays after 4 p.m. and during the day on weekends. This is a non-AEA role. The role will be cast with more than one actor to alternate performances.

Auditions will be held at Syracuse Stage (820 E. Genesee St., Syracuse, NY, 13210) on Saturday, March 2, 2024, from 12:00-2:00PM.
